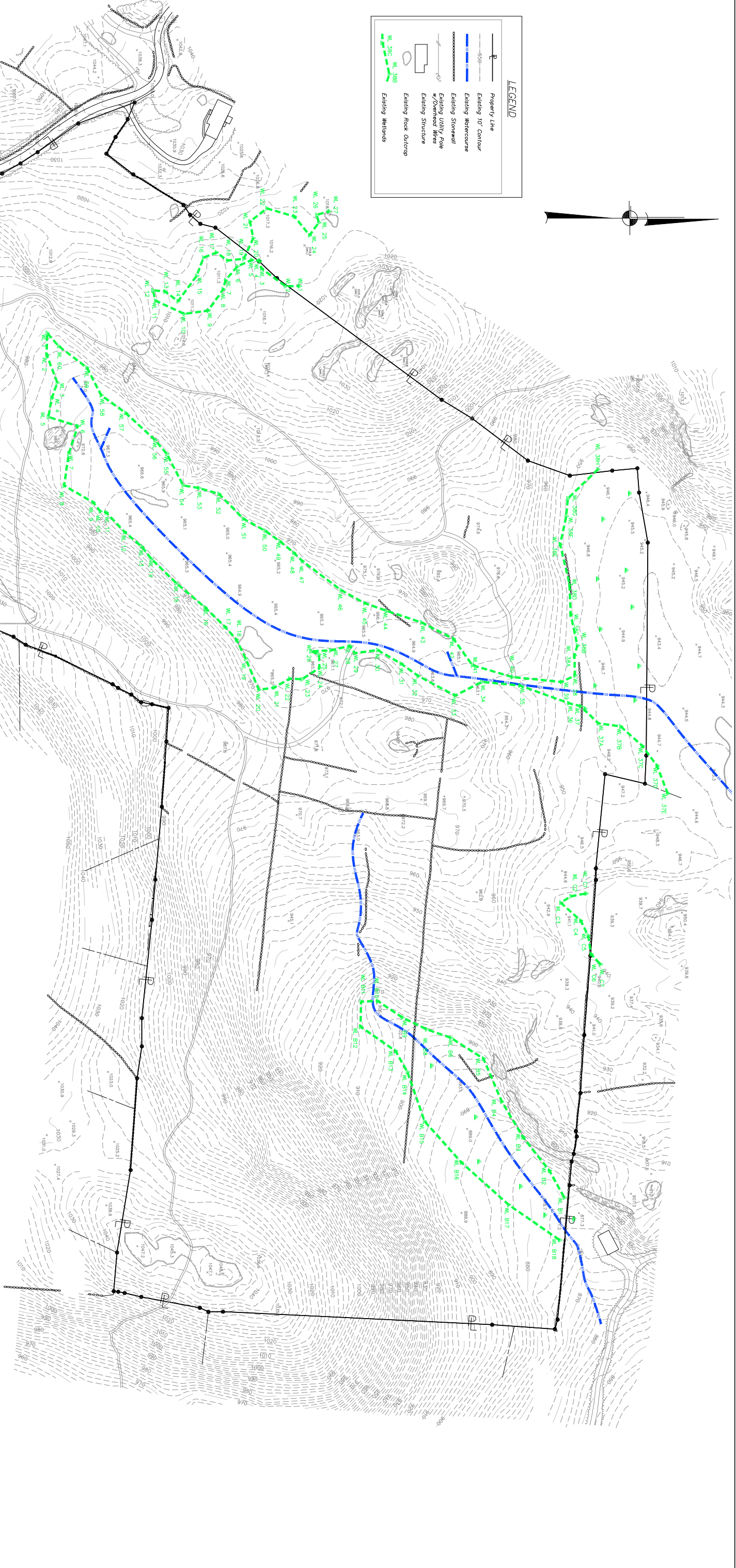

Wetland boundary delineations as validated by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation are subject to change. After 10 years the boundary must be revalidated by DEC staff. Revalidation may include a new delineation and survey of the wetland boundary.

Any proposed construction, grading, filling, excavating, clearing or other regulated activity in the freshwater wetland or adjacent 100 feet as depicted on this plan requires a permit from the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation under Article 24 of the Environmental Conservation Law (Freshwater Wetlands Act) prior to commencement of work.
